COVID TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS:

- Passengers must have a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (**COVID-19**) PCR test result. The test must have been taken within 96 hours from the date of sample collection before arrival. This may be subject to change at any time therefore it is best to reconfirm. This does not apply to passengers holding a diplomatic passport and their accompanying family members, provided they are holding a negative **PCR** test certificate obtained within 7 days before arrival.
- Passengers must hold a QR code showing they have completed a Travelers Health Surveillance Form online prior to departure. This is completed online here: https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/
- Passengers must have a body temperature that is not above **37.5°C (99.5°F)** and must not have any symptoms of coronavirus.
