## Dear All,

It has been a long two weeks for us here with substantial rain in Nairobi, the Great Rift Valley and especially in the Mara!

COVID-19 up-dates from Kenya are simply that we have a very slow increase in infections. As of today, the infections are **374** in total.

Testing is now sped up to quicker results and many quarantine centers have been dissolved. There is a theory that the warm weather slows the spread, perhaps there is some truth in it. We really hope so! Contact tracing continues and the Government is very serious in all its actions.

Measures of lock-downs in the coastal counties and Nairobi are mandatory and every citizen is now having to wear a mask. Road controls with temperature checks are the norm and many of our Kenyans are super-innovative! University students are building ventilators and many businesses have resolved to production of masks - mostly hand made. We don't want to rely on China's imports but be self-reliant.

The wonderful and positive news is that we have managed to collect almost **USD. 2,500.00** for donations for our wonderful **KOROGOCHO SLUM PROJECT!** I have been overwhelmed with gratitude for the generosity that our guests have displayed and I am so thankful on behalf of the families and children of Korogocho and our Florence who continues to work tirelessly to visit homes and people to distribute food, masks and soap. We are doing another distribution tomorrow and pls. find below some images from last week's donation!
