We are happy to send you a little update on our beautiful country Kenya!

COVID-19 UP-DATE:

Kenya's Infection rates are increasing still very slowly and they currently stand at 6,941 positive cases as of today whereby 2,109 have recovered and we have had 152 deaths only. Nairobi is still in lock-down until 6th of July and we are expecting this to be lifted this weekend to enable Domestic Travel & Tourism to start immediately. International flights are yet to be confirmed but there is indication that Kenya Airways may start flying internationally again from the 14th of July. We can only be certain once our President announces that international airspace has fully opened up.

- Engagement of Sunworld Guides & virtual game drives / reporting to rangers in Reserves on on-goings in the parks

PROJECT with Florence who tirelessly and selflessly helps families with food donations. The slums are especially hard hit during this period! Children who used to scavange the nearby dumpsite in Korogogocho Slum go now hungry as the



Airport Hotels that used to dump the leftover foods no longer operate. We are cooking / providing maizemeal and greens, lentils & rice, tea and mandazi, tea and bread with jam, beans and maizemeal about 5 days in a week on a regular basis.

In addition to food donations we have provided **100 blankets** and **clothes** for the street children and continue to being in need of the same as well as **used cooking oil** to create **castile soap.**
